TARGET

My vision Eugene says: *"is to see Churches planted in all the villages and towns in the hinterland, areas which have been neglected for so long.*

Statistics by the Ghana Evangelism Committee confirm that there are 14,000 unchurched towns and villages in Ghana alone.

Reaching these people will mean training more people, than we have now, for the work. It would take a greater sense of dedication to the Lord in order to accomplish this task.

We have already seen great results and are convinced that God is going to help us fulfill this vision".

2007 First Quarter Results

We worked in three separate districts in the Ashanti Region. Dwinyama, South Suntreso and Nyinahin all close to Kumasi. A breakdown of the results for the quarter in review is as follows:

We preached to about **22,000** people with **11,000** taking decisions for Christ. We had **31** Film Crusades, visited **40** schools and organized **5** Evangelism Seminars.

Our total church planting stands at **160** in our 20 years of ministry.

The table below describes the result of our activities for January to March.

A CHRISTIAN CHURCH IN A MUSLIM COMMUNITY

Attakrom is a small community without a church and dominated by Muslims. It is about a one hour drive from Kumasi on the Sunyani road. A church was started on January 19, 2007 after our film crusade and since then, Sunday church services are taking place there every week. The leader for this new church walks from another distant village to Attakrom, and needs a bicycle for his transportation. He has not been effective in following up with new members of the church due to lack of transport. A bicycle will enhance his evangelism work around the surrounding villages and also help in his follow-up work. Please pray that this and other needs of the young church will be met.

Anthony Yeboah said he lives in a different district, but was invited to attend one of our seminars at Subronum near Dwinyama. He accepted the invitation because he dreamed of attending a forum where he would learn how to take his relationship with God more seriously. He was glad for attending and learning so many new things by the end of the

seminar. He was blessed to know the short method to present the salvation message to the lost.

Emmanuel Ahin said; “I thought when one accepts Jesus as his Lord and Savior, and sins thereafter, he has to accept Christ again. I am happy to learn that Jesus is received into a person’s heart only once, but there is a need for rededication when one falls.”

Emmanuel Antwi said the seminar was an eye-opener to him. He went on to say that he thought he could hide his sins and continue to live a happy life. He now understands 1 John 1:9 and the provision God has made for him in case he falls into sin.

ROBBERY

Monday, January 22, 2007 was a dark day in the life of Eugene Narh’s family. My wife Emma was away at work when thieves broke into our house and made away with our properties, including money for our first quarter project and remittances for the staff of RPM. This was a painful challenge that came at the time the team was in the Ashanti Region of Ghana for an outreach. We would like you to continue to pray with us as we plan to relocate.

MINISTRY NEEDS

As many of you are aware, we are still trusting the Lord to replace our old 4x4 double cabin Toyota truck. Also, some of our urgent needs are a 220-240 volts power generator, some full range speaker boxes, a powerful amplifier and cordless microphones. We are also believing in the Lord to receive a cinema van (a container-built truck) for our projects. It is much safer to carry all of our equipment in a container vehicle, especially considering our remote mission fields.

We are a FAITH- BASED ministry. Our budget funds are realized only through the gifts of our friends and partners like you, who believe in what we are doing. Pray with us for the Lord to raise individuals, who will support this ministry on a regular basis. We pray that you will be part of our mission work, if you are not already involved.
